- 2) The decision made by our committee members will be final.
- 3) Scholarship rewards are awarded to students of members who are full time students at any local Universities, Secondary and Primary schools (both government and private) during the year of 2016 (please enclose the school certified duplicate copy of the result).

- 5) Academic requirement:
 - a. Primary school : At least 3 subjects with 'A's (80 marks and above)
 - b. Secondary School : From Remove Class to Form 4 (Chinese Private School Form 1 to Form 5) – at least 2 'A's (80 marks and above) with 2 'B's (70 marks and above) or 1 'A' (80 marks and above) with 3 'B's (70 marks and above)
 - c. Chinese Private Secondary UEC result: At least 2 'A's with 2 'B's; or 3 'A's with 2 'C's.
 - d. Government Examination
 - i. PT3 - At least 3 'A's
 - ii. SPM - Aggregate not more than 15 marks
 - iii. STPM - At least 1 'A's with 2 'B's
 - iv. A-Level - At least 1 'A' with 2 'B's
 - e. University Level – result with pass status to proceed to the next semester.
 - f. All candidates must have a minimum of grade 'B' for the 'Conduct'.
